Long-term Effects of Early Parenting Support

At the University of Gothenburg, a study is being conducted on how different forms of early support for parents within child healthcare impact children's health and development.

After your visit to the child health center (BVC), you will have the opportunity to answer questions in a questionnaire. The questions relate to you as a parent and your child's development and health. It takes approximately 20–30 minutes to complete the questionnaire.

Participation is voluntary. Your responses and information about you and your child will only be accessible to the research team. The study results will be presented in a way that ensures no one can identify your individual answers.

Your responses will contribute to increased knowledge about the importance of early support for parents and its impact on children and families.
