VGR, MSB and the Swedish Transport Administration in unique collaboration

Region Västra Götalandsregionen (VGR), the Swedish Transport Administration (Trafikverket) and the Swedish Civil Contingencies Agency (MSB) are preparing to interconnect their 5G networks.

The three organizations are currently exploring the possibilities of linking their respective 5G networks. This would allow MSB's and the Swedish Transport Administration's connected devices (mobile phones, computers, etc.) to use VGR's 5G network, and vice versa.

The main goal of this technical collaboration is to gain a common understanding of the challenges that may arise and how they can be minimized, with the aim of achieving a seamless experience for end users moving between the coverage areas of VGR, MSB and the Swedish Transport Administration.

Tests will be carried out using VGR SIM cards, and conversely SIM cards from MSB and the Swedish Transport Administration, in the existing radio and core network infrastructures. The first tests are planned to begin during the second quarter of 2024.
