VGR moves forward with next step in establishing its own 5G network

Region Västra Götalandsregionen (VGR) is now proceeding with the next phase of establishing its private 5G network, VGR-5G. Following a successful pilot at a limited part of Kungälv Hospital, a call-off has now been issued to complete the rollout across the entire hospital – phase 1 of the initiative.

The pilot has focused entirely on gathering experience, both for the overall program and for the products and services affected by the introduction of VGR-5G, such as telephony, alarms and messaging, support, and more. The pilot is now in its final phase and can be summarized as highly successful. The VGR-5G signal is established in a limited area of Kungälv Hospital, and the quality of voice calls, among other things, has been reported as very good.

The call-off concerns RAN (Radio Access Network) and is part of a renewed competition. The goal of VGR-5G is to increase autonomy, ensure robust communication in both daily operations and crisis situations, and enable innovation in areas such as healthcare and public transport. In total, the rollout is planned for approximately 25 mission-critical sites across the region.
