## Nordic media organizations show interest in VGR:s 5G initiative

**SVT, NRK and TV 2 recently visited VGR for a study tour. The meeting highlighted shared needs for robust and accessible mobile networks for critical public services, as well as an ambition to deepen Nordic collaboration.**

On 11 February, Region Västra Götaland (VGR) and the VGR-5G programme hosted representatives from Sveriges Television, NRK and TV 2. The purpose of the visit was to learn more about VGR:s strategic direction for 5G and how the initiative is being implemented in practice.

During the day, VGR presented its target vision, network architecture and principles for redundancy and resilience, as well as issues relating to coverage, capacity, monitoring, and operations. The focus was on how 5G can support secure and cost-effective communications for critical public services.

The Nordic media organizations described a growing need for 5G for production and distribution with high requirements for real-time performance and availability—requirements that are also highly relevant to VGR:s operations.

The meeting identified several shared development areas where collaboration could deliver mutual benefits and improve conditions by jointly advancing cross-border issues such as the need for resilience and prioritisation in public mobile networks, as well as long-term access to radio spectrum.
