A person with chlamydia has stated that you two have had sex. You may be infected.

Chlamydia is a bacteria that is transmitted through sexual contact. Chlamydia is often asymptomatic, but can sometimes cause discharge and a burning sensation in the urethra. The infection can spread to the testicles in men and to the fallopian tubes in women, and it is a cause of infertility. Chlamydia can be treated with antibiotic tablets. You may be infected with chlamydia, which is why you must be tested according to the Communicable Diseases Act.

A test sample is taken from your urine, vagina or rectum, depending on how you had sex. Please contact a youth guidance center, health center or an STI clinic and book an appointment for testing. Everything during the visit is confidential.

Testing and antibiotics are free of charge. If you have already been tested, please call the phone number below.

You need to: • get tested within two weeks

• take this letter with you to your visit

If you are going to have sex before receiving your test results, please use a condom or similar protection.
