A person with chlamydia has stated that you two have had sex. You may be infected.

Chlamydia is a bacteria that is transmitted through sexual contact. Chlamydia is often asymptomatic, but can sometimes cause discharge and a burning sensation in the urethra. The infection can spread to the testicles in men and to the fallopian tubes in women, and it is a cause of infertility. Chlamydia can be treated with antibiotic tablets. You may be infected with chlamydia, which is why you must be tested according to the Communicable Diseases Act.

A test sample is taken from your urine, vagina or rectum, depending on how you had sex. Please contact a youth guidance center, health center or an STI clinic and book an appointment for testing. Everything during the visit is confidential. You can also get a test via 1177.se/provhantering.

Testing and antibiotics is free of charge. If you have already been tested, please call the phone number below or notify us via 1177.se.

You need to:

- get tested within two weeks
- take this letter with you to your visit

If you are going to have sex before receiving your test results, please use a condom or similar protection.
